Procedure

- 1. Remove both front wheels (refer to Service Manual procedure 34015001).
- 2. Raise the vehicle to the proper working height, and then engage the safety locks on the 2 post lift (refer to the Service Manual <u>procedure</u>).
- 3. Support the LH front lower control arm with the underhoist stand (Figure 1).



4. Remove and discard the nut that attaches the LH FUCA to the LH front knuckle (torque 85 Nm) (Figure 2).

- 5. Separate the LH FUCA and LH front knuckle enough so that their mating surfaces can be inspected.
 - TIP: Adjust the underhoist stand as needed.

- 6. Inspect the mating surfaces of the LH FUCA and LH front knuckle.
 - If the top of the knuckle has a cone-shaped recess (Figure 3) and the FUCA ball joint stud has an alignment cone (Figure 4), replacement is unnecessary. Position the parts for reinstallation and install a new nut that attaches the LH FUCA to the LH front knuckle (torque 85 Nm) (Figure 2).

• If the top of the knuckle is flat (Figure 5), and the FUCA ball joint stud does NOT have an alignment cone (Figure 6), replacement is unnecessary. Position the parts for reinstallation and install a new nut that attaches the LH FUCA to the LH front knuckle (torque 85 Nm) (Figure 2).



- If either the knuckle or the FUCA have the cone-shaped feature (Figures 3 or 4) while the other part does <u>not</u> have the cone-shaped feature (Figures 5 or 6), the front knuckle and the FUCA require replacement. Take note and continue to the next step.
- 7. Repeat steps 3–6 on the RH front suspension.
- 8. Determine the next steps:
 - If no front suspension components require replacement, discontinue this procedure and skip to step 9. Use correction code S022431001.
 - If front suspension components require replacement, replace the parts as instructed in the Service Manual. If replacing one knuckle and FUCA, use correction code S032431001. If replacing both knuckles and FUCAs, use correction code S042431001.
 - o Front Knuckle Assembly (refer to Service Manual procedure 3101055022)
 - o Front Upper Control Arm (refer to Service Manual procedure 3101065012)
- 9. Reinstall all parts that were removed for access.
