Model 3 (2017-2023) and Model Y Headlamp Replacement Guidelines

Tech Notes are announcements that help to communicate new information about Tesla Service. These instructions assume knowledge of motor vehicle and, if applicable, high voltage electrical component repairs, and should only be executed by trained professionals. For proper headlamp operation in Model 3 and Model Y vehicles, both headlamps must be of the same type (Global or SAE), and the vehicle software configuration must match the installed headlamp type. If one headlamp is damaged, and the replacement headlamp is not the same type (Global or SAE) as the undamaged headlamp, the undamaged headlamp must also be replaced.

If an SAE type headlamp is damaged, replace both the damaged and the undamaged SAE headlamps with Global headlamps.
